## Spotlight on the Gallery, by Felix Bonomo, Gallery Director

Many of our artists like to take advantage of the opportunity to submit shrink wrap and/or cards during take-in. And the gallery likes having these items available for sale too.

The rule on shrink wrap and/or cards can be found on our web site under "Policies and Forms" and is called, "Art Show Rules and Category Definitions". With your fee paid entry into a monthly show, you may submit up to three shrink wraps for three months, with a maximum of nine in the gallery at any time. The same fee paid

regular entry also entitles you to submit up to three packs of note cards for three months, but the maximum number allowed in the gallery at any time is three packs. The Gallery Director (that would be me) has the right to restrict entries due to space limitations in the gallery.

I got to be the bad guy during January take-in and enforce the regulation. I'm not crazy about being the bad guy, but space for cards in the gallery is extremely limited. Unfortunately, they were starting to

display one on top of the other—not exactly an equitable (or artistic) arrangement for anyone.

The shrink wrap and card limits will be enforced at each take in. We are looking to purchase a new card rack that will permit a larger and nicer display of our cards for sale, but for now, we have to make do with the current arrangement and rules. Thank you for your consideration and courtesy to our take-in crew—particularly on shrink wrap!
