Beverly is a life-long artist and studied with Robert Landry, Carl Provder and Charles Reid. She received her art degree from San Diego State University.

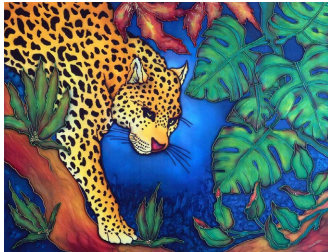
There are no hidden messages in her art. The images are basically to evoke a smile and stir the music within yourself.
