COAL Gallery Framing-Guideline's-A Reminder: It is incumbent on ALL Members to become familiar with our "Art Show Rules, Definitions and Categories", so that your art is NOT rejected from being displayed. CD

"Oils & Acrylics (O/A) Original oil and/or acrylic paintings done on canvas or other non-paper substrate, (e.g. Masonite). Canvas may be gallery wrapped, with the canvas wrapped around the edges. The edges must be painted. If staples show on the stretched canvas, the work must be framed. Glass is never used over the painting."

Here is what's required.

1. Maintain featured artist schedule (12-month+ schedule already exists-just needs adding to)
 2. Notify upcoming artist 2 months ahead of date by sending a copy of the guidelines (guideline letter exists).
 3. Remind artist 2 weeks ahead of date that they need to bring artwork and entry forms in on Take-in day.
 4. Remind artist that they are responsible for hanging their own work. If that is not possible they need to make arrangements with hanging committee chairperson
 5. Provide sign for artist if necessary (template exists)
